Respect	Use positive language. Always say “please” and “thank you.” Respect personal space and property.	Give yourself and others privacy.	Yield the right of way when appropriate. Excellence	Walk quietly in a single file line, facing forward, hands to yourself and one square apart.	Wait for your turn.	Enter and exit using the appropriate door.	Sit up tall in your seat lean back and keep feet on the floor.	Use utensils to eat your food.	Return to class on time.	Learn a new game/teach others how to play new game.
